## **G-Killer** parachute



G-Killer is a small parachute that significantly reduces G-forces during descent in a deep spiral. Its use helps to achieve a higher sink rate with fewer turns.

G-Killer is simple and easy to use and is particularly effective for competition class and higher aspect ratio wings.

## ATTACHING THE G-Killer

The G-Killer can only be used with a competition harness which has a special pocket for such a parachute. We do not recommend attaching to the harness using the reserve parachute connection point on the shoulder.



Attach the main bridle (1) to either the left or right main hang point karabiner. The bridle should be attached to the other side which you are going to do spiral: for example, If you wish to spiral to the right, the bridle should be connected to the left side in your harness.

## **INSTRUCTION FOR USE**

The G-Killer must be properly attached to your harness. First, the G-Killer opens and then the pilot performs the spiral.

- Open the zipper on the pocket of your harness where the G-Killer is.
- Take hold of the parachute and throw it in a sideways or rearward direction to the side. (we recommend that the bridle should be attached to the other side which you are going to do spiral).
- Start spinning the spiral.
- When you have descended to a safe altitude, exit smoothly the spiral dive.
- After stabilization your flight, the G-Killer should be disabled.

To disable the G-Killer, pull the center line towards you and fasten to the magnet (2) at the mount located in the harness. It is recommended to land safely with a disabled G-Killer rather then attempting to put it back to the harness pocket.

! DO NOT try to pack the parachute back on-board your harness. It can re-opening and cause an obstacle to the view, especially during the landing approach.
